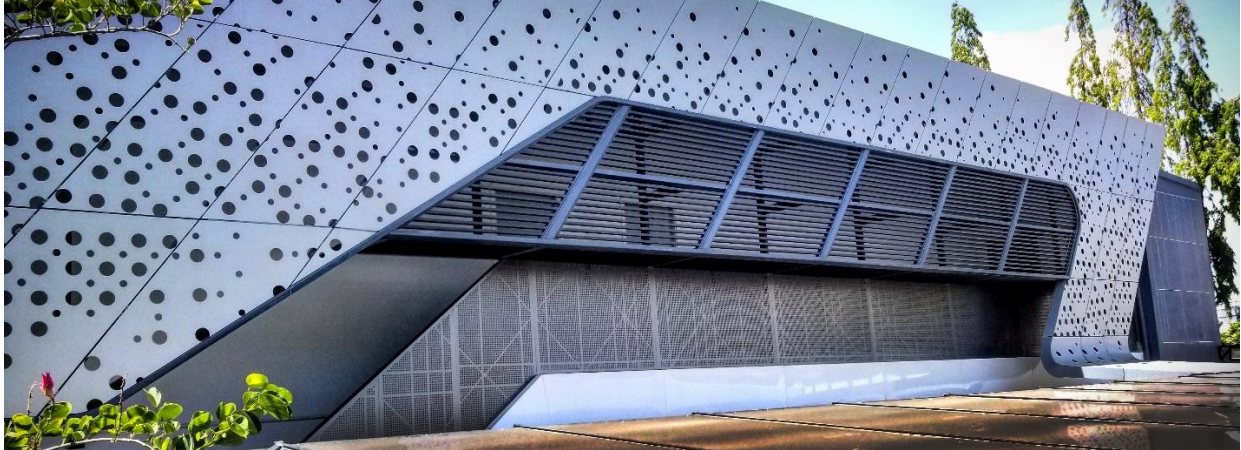
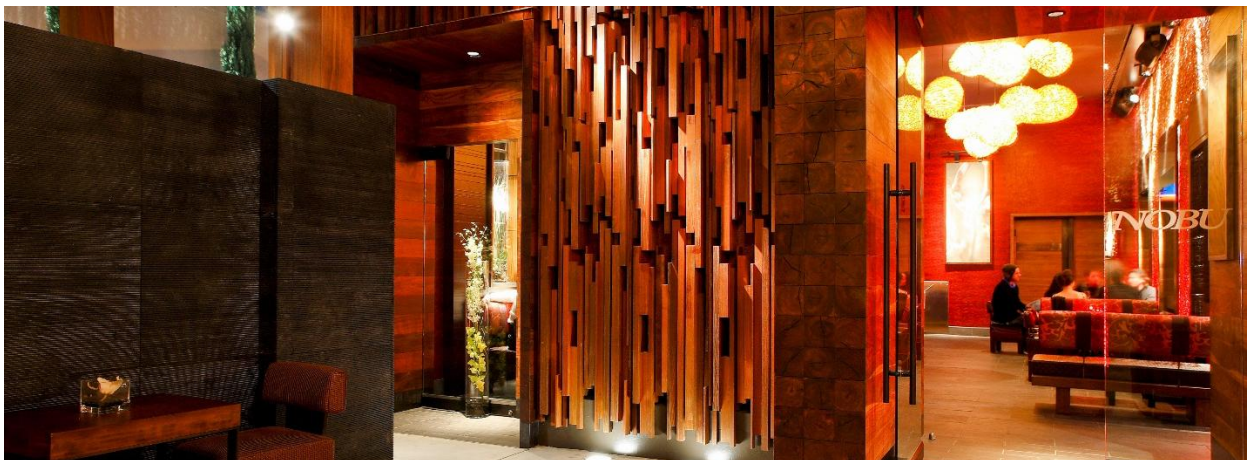

DA/D, a multidisciplinary design firm concept derives from geometries and colors which are the two main dictators of humans' design environment. DA/D specializes in high-end modern architectural and interior design with offices in Bangkok, Thailand and Miami, USA. DA/D has worked on a wide range of projects in the US, Thailand, Singapore, Taiwan, Cambodia, and Myanmar from multimillion dollars private residences to five stars restaurants, commercial buildings, community malls, museums interiors / installations along with bespoke furniture design all of which focuses on sustainability.





DA/D has completed many significant architectural and interior design projects in the US for clients such as the Miami Science Museum, Nobu Restaurants, Distrito Restaurants, Sustain Restaurant, Lotus Le Mans Hospitality Lounge, Plainsboro Public Library New York, Neiman Marcus, Saks Fifth Ave, The James Hotel, Parker Meridien, and Hyatt Regency and has collaborated with top design firms such as the Rockwell Group, Crème Design, the Getty's Group, Gensler, BSKS architects and Stan Allen Architects. In Thailand DA/D has completed several remarkable projects such as a 15 story Pratumwan District Head Office, 8 story Thailand Baby Best Buy HQ office, Chanchai Engineering office & warehouse, BPK HQ office, PTT office interiors and countless high-end residential projects. DA/D also completed the design for HKL Head office building in Cambodia, The Envoy restaurant/hotel in Myanmar, and Siam More restaurant in Taiwan, and private residences in Singapore.

DA/D's furniture sector known as PIE studio has been selected as one of the top 20 eco design product exhibiting at the Shelburne Museum Vermont, exhibited at the largest green design exhibition in Europe: *Matières à cultiver* in Paris, Clean Break green exhibition with Design Philadelphia, a solo installation at Bridge Gallery NYC during the New York Design Week 2008 and chosen to collaborate with LEXUS sustainable lifestyle concept, "LEXUS Hybrid Living" as one of its feature designers. In 2006 the Steel Tongue chair designed by Bannavis Andrew Sribyatta, DA/D's design director, became a permanent collection to the Cooper Hewitt, National Design Museum - Smithsonian Institution NYC. DA/D design was called "Best of the Best" and received an award by Florida International Magazine. The Sushi Daybed received Best of Year Award in 2008 for outdoor seating selected by Interior Design Magazine.

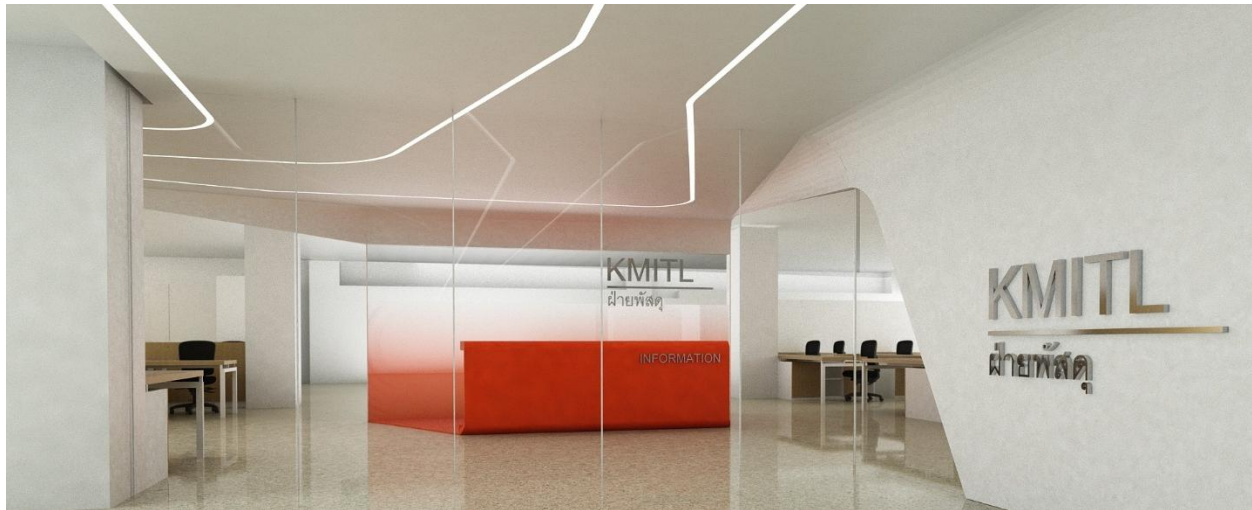
